- 5. Products must be purchased and installed between June 1, 2021, and March 31, 2026. Rebate applications must be postmarked by April 1, 2026.
- 6. Rebate application with valid customer account number must be accompanied by a legible copy of the paid itemized sales receipt showing proof of purchase that includes manufacturer, model number, store/name, store location, purchase price, and date of purchase.
- 7. Individual measure rebate amounts cannot exceed the total cost of product and installation.
- 8. Payment will be issued to the account holder and service address on record with applicable FirstEnergy Pennsylvania utility, unless otherwise indicated to issue to contractor.
- 9. Please allow up to 30 days from the date all required information is received to process your rebate.
- 10. All rebated products must be installed at the service address specified on the rebate application.
